#### CLASS 1 - VETERAN DOG (3 Entries)

##### **1st : Newman's - CH. WOFLERLOW BORDER PATROL**

A 7 year old tricolour boy with super construction and movement, belying his age. Good head, leathers and eye. Good front and keel with very tight feet. Well ribbed which gave him his excellent topline. Strong hindquarters. **Best Veteran Dog**

##### **2nd : Storton's - CH. DEREHEATH JOLLY JON**

Amazing 11 year old in excellent condition. Another good male of correct construction. Lovely head and eye. Good leathers. Good steady mover, not quite the topline of my winner.

##### **3rd : Watkins' - BLACKVEIN PILGRIM**

#### CLASS 2 - MINOR PUPPY DOG (2 Entries)

##### **1st : Cudlip's - HARVIDENE BREAKAWAY**

Glorious puppy, with so much potential. Very good head and eye. Correct fold to leathers. Great front, shoulders and keel. Good topline and strong in hindquarters. Moved very well pushed hard for top honours just lost on maturity today. Must have a super future. **Best Puppy Dog.**

##### **2nd : Henderson's - LONGMYND VIKINGS SPIRIT**

This dog is of different type, smaller throughout. Pleasing head. A bit shorter in upper arm and could have more keel. Good feet. Not as mature as winner. Moved quite well.

#### CLASS 3 - PUPPY DOG (1 Entry)

##### **1st : Jones' - FIDANZA JACKSON'S THRILLER AT GENNOME**

10 month tricolour. Ok for size. Skull planes OK, but his ears are completely flat against his head. Short in upper arm. Sufficient keel. High in the rear when he moved. Nicely presented.

#### **CLASS 4 - JUNIOR DOG (5 Entries)**

**1st : Newman's - WOFLERLOW ROCKAFELLA**

Not a strong class but headed by a very nice dark tricolour youngster. Good size, well constructed dog with good ribs and topline. Correct head and leathers. Moved well.

**2nd : Matthews-Brown's - HOUNSBAY DONATELLO**

Bigger dog with a good head and amazing leathers! Good front and keel, slightly short in ribbing for his size and so stood high in the rear. Moved OK.

**3rd : McIntosh's - KELANSUE WORKING ON A DREAM**

Red and white with good topline and ribbing. Head planes OK. Short in upper arm.

#### **CLASS 5 - YEARLING DOG (12-24 Months) (3 Entries)**

**1st : Austin & Down's - LONGMYND UNDAUNTED**

Dark tricolour with a good head and correct leathers. Well ribbed youngster with sufficient keel and good layback of shoulder. Good feet. Needs to tighten up behind.

**2nd : McEvedy's - DEARDUENNA BOURGUIGNONNE**

Dearduenna Bourguignonne. Looked good stood. Good size and nice tight feet. Lacks completely in keel which shows in his close front movement. Hindquarters are strong and he moved well behind.

**3rd : Allchorne's - BRACENACRE INTREPID**

Nice for size and pleasing head. Short in upper arm. Ribbing well back.

#### **CLASS 8 - POST GRADUATE DOG (11 Entries / 4 Absent)**

**1st : O'Loughlin's - BASSBARR IVAN IDEA (IMP HUN)**

lovely dark blanket tricolour of good size and excellent construction throughout. Excellent head and correct leathers. Good eye. Correct shoulders, great keel and tight feet. Ribs go well back and he retains his topline both stood and moving. Strong behind, he could not stand wrong. Very promising two year old. **Reserve Dog CC.**

### **CLASS 8 - POST GRADUATE DOG (Cont'd)**

**2nd : McEvedy's - DEARDUENNA STROGANOFF AT DEREHEATH**

This light tricolour of good size to which much of the above applies. Not the reach and drive in front as my winner, possibly as he is heavier over the shoulder. Another well ribbed one with sufficient keel. He looked a picture.

**3rd : Danson's - SEDONIA DOUBLE DECKER (TAF)**

A very elegant headed tricolour. Well ribbed. Turns his feet a little.

**Res : Titley's - BUCKADOE BOMBADIER**

### **CLASS 9 - MID LIMIT DOG (2 Entries / 1 Absent)**

**1st : Storton, Melbourne & Isted's -**

**DEREHEATH GOING DUTCH AT DEARDUENNA**

Dereheath Going Dutch at Dearduenna. Two dogs of different type. Winner is quite a heavy dog with a pleasing head and good leathers. Good keel and ribbing. . Good shoulders, feet and topline. Moved well.

**2nd : Storton's - JACTORIA TORNADO AT DEREHEATH**

Smaller dog with a nice head and good leathers. Heavier over the shoulders and lower to ground. Well ribbed with good front and feet. Preferred the scope on the move of my winner.

### **CLASS 10 - LIMIT DOG (5 Entries)**

**1st : Storton, Melbourne & Isted's - DIHEATH MAXIMUS**

This youngster caught my eye as he entered the ring and did not disappoint. Super noble elegant head. Good leathers and nice tight eye. Good front and feet. Plenty of keel and ribs go well back. Retains his topline on the move. Lovely outline and moved very well. CC his second I understand. I gave his sire his first.! Delighted to see him win BIS under referee Mrs Betty White.

**Dog CC and Best in Show**

**2nd : O'Loughlin's - BASSBARR HEAVY METAL (IMP HUN)**

Another lovely dog of excellent type and construction with good shoulders and ribbing and a strong noble head and correct leathers. Just a little narrower in front than the winner, but challenged hard for Reserve CC.

**3rd : Watkins' - BLACKVEIN SARACEN**

Nice type hound but not the front construction of my two winners.

### **CLASS 11 - OPEN DOG (5 Entries / 1 Absent)**

Not an easy class as this, 4 hounds of differing types

**1st : Seddon's - CH. RIBBLERIVER SHOW ME OFF AT SEDONIA**

A smart dog who has a a good head and eye, correct leathers, good shoulders and feet. Well ribbed and steady in topline. Excels in hindquarters, very strong and parallel on the move. I would prefer more width in forechest. Pushed hard for reserve CC.

**2nd : Storton's - CH. BUZZ LIGHTYEAR AT DEREHEATH**

Heavier dog, and rather low for me , but his overall construction cannot be faulted. He moved with drive but not the topline of the winner today.

**3rd : Storton's - DEREHEATH GUNNAR**

Sire of my second place. Orange/white of good type and construction.

**Res : Ellrich's - MALRICH SIR RUFF DIAMOND**

### **CLASS 12 - BREEDERS DOG (2 Entries)**

**1st : McIntosh's - KELANSUE WORKING ON A DREAM**

3rd in Junior a tricolour with a good head and leathers. Nice feet. Sufficient keel. Would prefer ribcage to go further back. A little high in the rear.

**2nd : Titley's - BUCKADOE BOMBADIER**

4th in in Post Graduate. Nice moving dog. Head pleasing with correct leathers. Sufficient keel. Tight feet. A bit heavy over the shoulders and high in the rear. Not as masculine as my winner.

#### **2nd : McIntosh's - FABURN LOMAND AT KELANSUE**

8yr. old Red & White, feminine head , good leathers, level topline, firm hindquarters, well presented.

### **CLASS 14 - MINOR PUPPY BITCH (5 Entries / 1 Absent)**

#### **1st : Hudson's - HARVIDENE COOKIE OF GRACEMINSTER**

Broken tri. good head & expression, supple leathers, strong neck, sound well developed front, deep ribcage going well back, strong topline and muscular hindquarters, moved well.

#### **2nd : Rodgers & Armstrong's - SWITHERLAND RED IMAGE**

Red & White youngster, sweet head, supple leathers, good reach of neck, well developed forechest, good hind angulation, needs time to firm up a little more.

#### **3rd : Cartwright's - LONGMYND VELVET PROMISE**

**Res : Storton, Melbourne & Isted - DIHEATH DORIS DAY**

### **CLASS 15 - PUPPY BITCH (3 Entries / 1 Absent)**

#### **1st : O'Loughin's - BASSBARR QUEST FOR GLORY**

Compact balanced eye catching tri-colour, good head & leathers, strong neck with good reach, sound well developed front, strong short forelegs, tight feet, shoulders well layed back, firm level topline, muscular well developed hindquarters with good angulation, moved with drive.

**Best Puppy Bitch, Bitch CC and Best Puppy in Show, and Reserve Best in Show.**

#### **2nd : Murray & Fitzpatrick-Odahamier's - DIHEATH BETTE DAVIS**

Typy tri. good head, leathers & reach of neck, even front, level topline, well developed hindquarters, moved well.

### **CLASS 16 - JUNIOR BITCH (9 Entries / 3 Absent)**

#### **1st : Ledward's - DRAWDELL LADY DE WINTER**

Lemon & White with feminine head, good reach of neck, even well developed front, deep ribcage reaching well back, strong topline and muscular hindquarters giving driving action.

Gleaming black blanket, sweet head, supple leathers, sound even front, tight feet, good shoulder placement, strong level topline, rounded muscular hindquarters with neat little hocks.

Quality tri-colour, feminine head, supple leathers, firm well developed front, shoulders well layed back, strong forelegs, tight feet, firm level topline and muscular well developed hindquarters, moved with drive.

Another quality tri, good head, leathers and reach of neck, sound even front, strong topline, firm hindquarters, clean free movement.

Lovely with soft expression, strong arched neck, well developed even front, clean shoulders well layed back, deep ribcage reaching well back, firm rounded hindquarters with good angulation.
