and Best Puppy - Moralach Polly Pastilles for Barratini.

CLASS 1 - PUPPY DOG (5 Entries)

Good class, could change places another day.

1st : Ellrich's - Malrich Eisenhower

6 months tri, still a baby but a lot to offer, nicely proportioned head, dark eyes, good reach of neck, good sternum & front, ribs well sprung & bend of stifle good, nice low hocks, level topline. Movement a bit erratic, when settled moved well, Enjoyed Himself. **Best Puppy Dog.**

2nd : Storton's - Dereheat Moses

10 months, good head & dark eyes, sternum & front fine, ribcage carried well back, level topline, correct bend of stifle, moved well.

3rd : Allen's - Fivevalleys Forester

CLASS 2 - JUNIOR DOG (4 Entries / 2 Absent)

1st : Newman's - Woferlow Border Patrol

Tri with good bone, masculine head, dark eye, leather set & in-curling, good shoulder placement, level topline standing & on the move, well sprung ribs, good bend of stifle, moved with drive.

2nd : Storton's - Dereheath Gustaf

Red & white, smaller type to 1st, nice head, eyes could be a bit darker. Level front, tight feet. Preferred shoulders of 1st. Level topline, good bend of stifle, moved well.

CLASS 3 - MAIDEN DOG

CLASS 4 - NOVICE DOG (1 Entry)

1st : Allen's - Fivevalleys Forester

10 months Red & white, nice head, good eye shape, even front & shoulder placement, ribs well sprung, level topline standing & on the move, good bend of stifle, moved well. Enjoyed Himself.

CLASS 5 - POST GRADUATE DOG (5 Entries / 1 Absent)

1st : Kelsey's - Malacante Bay of Silence

Nice boy, lovely dark eye, earset correct on masculine head, good reach of neck, good sternum & layback of shoulders. Deep chest, level topline, good angulation behind, tight feet, moved out well. Needs to body up a bit more. **Reserve Best Dog.**

2nd : Storton's Dereheath Gunnar

Paler eye to 1st, ear placement good & fine textured, nice front & sternum. Shoulders not as good as 1st. Ribcage fine, good bend of stifle, nice tight feet, moved well around the ring.

3rd : Mitchell's - Chrizbee Rumpole

CLASS 6 - LIMIT DOG (1 Entry)

1st : Isted & Melbourne's - Dereheath Peridot at Dearduenna

Red & white, nice head & dark eye, good front & shoulder placement, rigcage of good length & well sprung, level topline, good bend of stifle, moved well, in hard condition.

CLASS 7 - OPEN DOG (7 Entries / 1 Absent)

1st : Haynes' - Harebolt Echo

Red & white of good length & bone, in good hard condition, masculine head & strong neck, dark eye, prominent sternum & level front, nice tight feet, good shoulder placement, level topline, ribs well sprung & carried well back, correct bend of stifle, really drove around the ring.

Best Dog and Reserve Best in Show.

2nd : Brown's - Langpool Midsummer Magic of St Hubert

Red & white I have always liked, masculine head, beautiful dark eye, correct lozenge shape, sternum & front correct with good shoulder placement. Rigcage well sprung & carried well back. Level topline, good bend of stifle, low hocks. Needs a bit more sparkle on the move, would do better, pressed 1st.

3rd : Broome's - Broomhurst Drummer Boy

CLASS 8 - VETERAN DOG or BITCH (7 Entries / 1 Absent)

What a pleasure, the oldies do their owners proud.

1st : Archer's - Andyne Overture to Roamanbay

11 years tri bitch, really enjoying herself, nice type, feminine head & dark eye, good ear placement & reach of neck, even front & sternum, correct shoulder placement, level topline, deep rigcage & length, good bend of stifle, moved really well for age. **Best Veteran in Show.**

2nd : Haynes' - Nedlaw Clementine at Harebolt

Red & white of nice type, good head & eye, correct ear placement, good front, sternum & shoulder placement, rigcage of good length & spring, well bent stifle, level topline, moved well.

3rd : Kelsey's - Malacante Hudson Bay

CLASS 9 - PUPPY BITCH (11 Entries / 5 Absent)

Good class, my placings could alter another day.

1st : Daykin's - Moralach Polly Pastilles for Barratini

Well made tri, nice head & bark eye, good reach of neck, good sternum & front, correct shoulder placement, ribcage well sprung & carried well back. Moved well, good bend of stifle.

Best Puppy Bitch and Best Puppy in Show.

2nd : Allen's - Fivevalleys Rum Punch

Tri, 10 months, pressed 1st hard, could easily change places on another occasion. Lovely head & expression, dark eyes, ears of good length, neck of good length, prominent sternum, good shoulder placement, ribcage of good length, well sprung, good bend of stifle giving her drive, moved well.

3rd : Newman's - Marabis Queens Council

CLASS 10 - JUNIOR BITCH (8 Entries / 3 Absent)

1st : Ellrich's - Malrich Calida

Tri, feminine head & kind expression with dark eye. Good sternum & even front, correct shoulder placement, ribcage of good depth, level topline, good bend of stifle, moved well.

2nd : Storton's - Dereheath Greta

Red & white, smaller mould to 1st. Good head & expression, even front & sternum, shoulders OK, level topline, good bend of stifle. Preferred length of 1st.

3rd : Newman's - Woferlow Dolly Mixture

CLASS 11 - MAIDEN BITCH (4 Entries / 1 Absent)

1st : Ellrich's - Malrich Calida

2nd : Beale's - Fivevalleys Tiger Lily

Red & white, smaller type to 1st. Very feminine, correct ear placement, neat front & feet, good body & bend of stifle. Moved happily around the ring, well handled.

3rd : Saunders' - Brunell Godiva for Houndsbay

CLASS 12 - NOVICE BITCH (2 Entries)

1st : Daykin's - Moralach Polly Pastilles for Barratini

2nd : Allen's - Fivevalleys Rum Punch

CLASS 13 - POST GRADUATE BITCH (10 Entries / 1 Absent)

1st : Beale's - Richsomes Love in Your Eyes

Dark tri ditch, very flashy, lovely dark eye & expression, fine textured ears, nice front & feet, good reach of neck & shoulder placement, ribs of good length & spring. Moved happily, handled well.

2nd : Newman's - Woferlow sweet dreamer

Tri, heavier type to 1st. Good head, eye & expression, ear placement correct. Nice front & sternum, level topline with ribs of nice length & spring, good bend of stifle. Lost out on movement, could have had more drive.

3rd : Storton's - Dereheath Maureen

CLASS 14 - LIMIT BITCH (8 Entries / 1 Absent)

1st : Feetham's - Kimbleholme Make A Wish

Red & white, lovely type, nice head & expression, in-curling leathers. Correct shoulder placement with good front & sternum, ribcage carried well back & sprung. Good bend of stifle, moved with drive.

Reserve Best Bitch.

CLASS 14 - LIMIT BITCH (Cont'd)

2nd : Storton's - Dereheath Margaret

Red & white, lovely head & expression, good sternum & front, ribcage of good length, good bend of stifle, level topline, moved with drive. Played handler up while standing, close to 1st.

3rd : Mease's - Dereheath Matilda

CLASS 15 - OPEN BITCH (4 Entries / 1 Absent)

1st : Scott's - Hamlock Harmony's Girl with Siouxline

Red & white, one I have always liked. Nice head & expression, in-curling leathers. Good sternum & front with tight feet, correct shoulder placement, good spring & length of rib. Level topline standing & on the move, good bend of stifle. Moved with drive, handled well.

Best Bitch and Best in Show.

2nd : Brown's - Langpool Moonlight and Roses of St.Hubert

Red & white, bigger mould to 1st. Good head with soft expression, good front & sternum, excellent ribbing of spring & length, topline level.

Could have moved better, kept her tail down, didn't really enjoy herself.

3rd : Mutton's - Whinneywoods Rose Queen
