1st Allchorne's – Nelgus Thyme Bomb

9 month old confident boy, nicely put together, moves soundly with drive for a young puppy. Liked his head, correct bite and good length of leather. He has good length of body and holds his topline well excellent bone.

2nd Melbourne & Murray's – Diheath Wreckless Eric

11 month old big boy with a happy outlook on life. Super male head, correct bite, plenty of length over all and there was little between these two but Eric just needs a bit more drive.

Class 3 – Junior Dog (2 Entries)

1st Williams' – Newdown Xavier-Xanthos At Brompt (Imp Nld)

Big lad in lovely condition, liked his head, masculine but kind expression. Good length of leather. He strode out well with drive, would just like a slightly tighter elbow. **Reserve Best Dog**

Well presented boy in lovely condition. Kind expression, correct bite, slightly finer head than 1st. He is well made plenty of bone, just a Little erratic on the move, probably because he was very keen.

Class 9 – Minor Puppy Bitch (2 Entries)

1st Cartwright's – Longmynd Yours Truly

A very nice dark tri girl, for one so young she was very balanced and therefore moved soundly. , liked her pretty head, with a correct bite, good length of leather, clean eyes, good reach of neck and plenty of length.

2nd Daelman's – Sedonia's Evolution with Bazettdael

Another very nice young bitch, feminine head with clear eyes, correct bite, and lovely leathers. She moves a little loose in front still but that should improve with more muscle tone.

Class 10 – Puppy Bitch (3 Entries)

1st Allchorne's – Nelgus Cinnamon Spice

Sweet headed girl, with a correct bite, good dark eye, enough neck but perhaps a bit more length of body would give her better balance. Plenty of bone and good feet.

2nd Hudson's – Diheath Crazy Daisy at Graceminster

This puppy scores in head and furnishings. At the moment her movement is a bit erratic but she is young and with exercise I would expect it to improve.

3rd Green's – Braithwell Peach Blossom

Class 11 – Junior Bitch (3 Entries / 1 Absent)

1st Green's – Braithwell's Dancing Queen

I liked this young bitch, she moved with drive on good feet and was sound fore and aft. She has plenty of neck going into well placed shoulders. And a nice length of back. Another pretty headed girl.

2nd McIntosh's – Knockogue Bon Bon at Kelansue (IKC)

Sweet feminine bitch with nice clean eyes, good leathers, and correct bite. I would have liked her to be a bit more balanced as this would help her to drive out more when moving. Looked very nice standing.

Class 12 – Novice Bitch (3 Entries)

1st McIntosh's – Knockogue Bon Bon at Kelansue (IKC)

2nd in Class 11 – Junior Bitch

2nd Lane's – Suaisa Take On Me at Lanebern

Nice bitch with plenty of body. A bit weighed down with a false pregnancy which never does a girl any favours. Teeth correct, kind expression

3rd Fryer. Fryer. Melbourne & Storton's – Diheath Steffi

Class 13 – Post Graduate Bitch (3 Entries / 1 Absent)

1st McIntosh's – Kelansue Reason to Believe

Nice looking bitch especially when standing. Pretty head, correct teeth, nice leathers, she has plenty of length of body, good shoulder placement. But at the moment she is rather loose in movement

Class 13 – Post Graduate Bitch (Cont'd)

2nd Pearson's – Armardio Almost an Angel, JW

Preferred head of 1st but these two bitches were very different from each other so could swap places another day. This bitch was smaller than 1, more compact, but she moved well

Class 14 – Limit Bitch (1 Entries)

1st Robertson's – Switherland Love to Gossip

Another pleasing bitch with a sweet head, clean eyes, and good leathers. She is sound in front movement and uses her hind legs with drive. I would have liked a little more length on her

Class 15 – Open Bitch (7 Entries / 2 Absent)

By far the best class of the day, really enjoyed it. Thank you for bringing such nice bitches for me to go over.

1st Williams' – Ch. Brathwells Miss Marple Of Bromp

Top quality bitch, moved with a 'look at me' attitude. Looked great standing. Good clean lines, beautiful head. Plenty of bone but retained her femininity.
